We advocated for early learning.

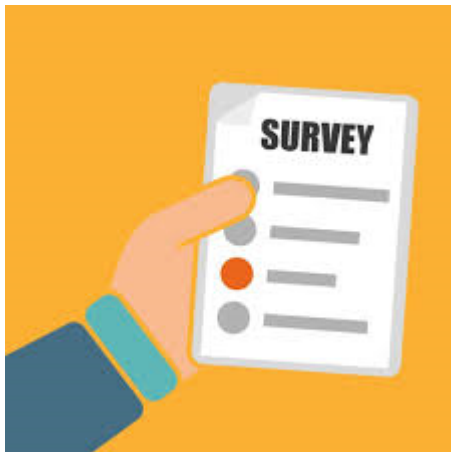
We were proud to partner with Choose Children for a screening of the documentary *No Small Matter* at The New Parkway in Oakland.

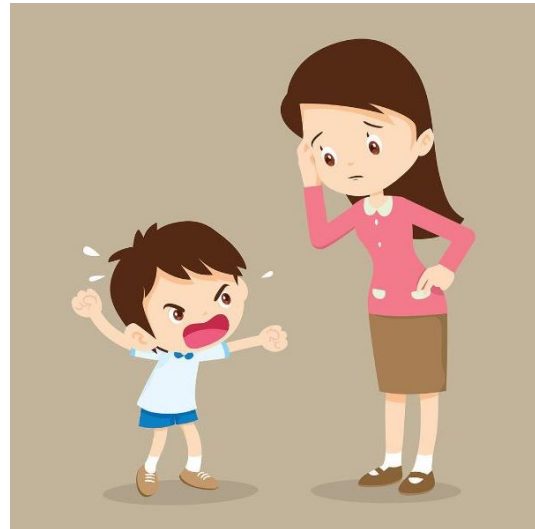
We gathered your feedback.
